Title: Naturalistic Decision-Making in Nursing: A Scoping Review

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Question: What is the current state of naturalistic decision-making research in nursing?

PCC

Population: Nurses

This scoping review will be about nurses who work within a healthcare setting, whether within acute care, long-term care, or community care. All nurses will be included within the literature search including Registered Nurses, Registered Practical Nurses/Licensed Practical Nurses, and Advanced Practice Nurses (including Clinical Nurse Specialists and Nurse Practitioners). The literature beyond the healthcare system will not be included. Nursing students, allied health, and patients will not be included.

Concept: Naturalistic Decision Making

The concept of interest will be naturalistic decision making. Consideration will be given to any way in which naturalistic decision making has been incorporated in the literature. Researchers and authors discussing decision-making which does not include naturalistic decision-making will not be included.

Context: Naturalistic Decision Making Relating to Nursing

Articles will be included if they have discussion of naturalistic decision making as it relates to healthcare and the healthcare setting. Those articles which do not include naturalistic decision making or do not 'discuss' this form of decision-making within the healthcare setting will not be included within this review.
